¿SABÍAS QUE?

- IELTS (International English Language Testing System) es el examen internacional de inglés con el mayor número de candidatos, anualmente más de 3 millones de personas.
- El examen IELTS es reconocido por más de 10.000 instituciones en más de 140 países.
- IELTS es uno de los pocos exámenes internacionales que incluyen una entrevista presencial para evaluar la habilidad de expresión oral.
- El examen IELTS evalúa las cuatro habilidades y está diseñado para reflejar la capacidad de comunicación en inglés en diferentes ámbitos (general y académico).



LISTENING

ACADEMIC TRAINING

The IELTS Listening test is designed to assess a wide range of listening skills, including how well you:

- Understand main ideas and specific factual information.
- Recognise the opinions, attitudes and purpose of a speaker.
- Follow the development of an argument.

QUESTIONS

There are 40 questions. A variety of question types is used, and you may be asked to:

- Answer multiple choice questions.
- Label a plan, map or diagram.
- Fill in a form.
- Complete a table.
- Complete a flow-chart.
- Give short answers.

MARKING

Each correct answer receives one mark. Scores out of 40 are converted to the IELTS 9-band scale. Scores are reported in whole and half bands.

AUDIO RECORDING

- You will hear a variety of accents e.g. British, American, Australian.
- Answer the questions as you listen because the recording is played once only.
- Some time is allowed during the recording to preview the questions.
- Answers are in the same order as the information on the recording.



You are allowed an extra **10 minutes** to transfer your answers from your question booklet to your answer sheet.

FOUR SECTIONS

The IELTS Listening test is broken down into four sections:

SECTION 1

You listen to a conversation between two people set in an everyday social situation, e.g. a conversation in an accommodation agency, and answer questions on your comprehension.

SECTION 2

You listen to a monologue set in an everyday social situation, e.g. a speech about local facilities or a talk about the arrangements for meals during a conference.

SECTION 3

You listen to a conversation between up to four people set in an educational or training context, e.g. a university tutor and a student discussing an assignment, or a group of students planning a research project.

SECTION 4

You listen to a monologue on an academic subject, e.g. a university lecture.

TASK SECTION 2

This is a sample of the listening section 2. You will practise matching information and multiple choice tasks. Other task types are possible in this section of the test.

MARKING



For both modules:

- A mark is given for each correct answer.
- Spelling is important. A spelling mistake counts as a wrong answer.
- Grammar is important: e.g. writing a singular instead of a plural noun counts as a wrong answer.
- Write answers clearly.

Illegible handwriting counts as a wrong answer.

- Answer the questions as you read and transfer to the answer sheet immediately.
- IELTS accepts both American and British English spelling but be consistent.
- A hyphenated word (e.g. absent-minded, flow-chart) counts as one word.



IELTS WRITING

Make the most of your Writing test:



- Analyse each task properly and spend some time making notes.
- Highlight or underline key words in the tasks to make sure that you focus on what you have to do.
- Plan your answers.
- Use paragraphs clearly; put one idea in each paragraph.
- Do not repeat ideas using different words.
- Do not copy whole sentences from the question – you will receive no marks for this.
- Keep to the topic; do not write about unrelated subjects.



IELTS SPEAKING

Make the most of your Speaking test:



- Try to talk as much as you can.
- Talk as fluently as possible and be spontaneous.
- Relax, be confident and enjoy using your English.
- Develop your answers.
- Speak more than the examiner.
- Ask for clarification if necessary.
